

#### How do I narrow the results?

- In TABLE view, click ALL TOPICS and select the topic you want. The table view will show only facts for that topic. To view all facts again, select All Topics.
- In MAP view, you can further narrow results down to counties, county subdivisions, or places by choosing a level from the BROWSE BY dropdown. The map will switch to browse mode. Click on a geography and set it as primary. The map will automatically switch back to data mode showing each of the geographies at that level color-coded according to their fact data value.
- In CHART view, you can toggle between all sibling geographies or geographies that you have selected via the ALL LOCATIONS dropdown.
- In DASHBOARD view, you can narrow down only what facts are showing by using the ALL TOPICS dropdown, as indicated above.


# Census Bureau's Center for Enterprise Dissemination Services and Consumer Innovation

CEDSCI will establish a modernized technology platform that leverages existing innovations to provide a set of shared data dissemination services that enable consumers to do more with the massive amounts of valuable content we publish year round.



# Alpha Phase 1 & 2 Feature Recap



## Summary of key features:

- **Data Explorer.** Supports the ability to explore data by selecting a topic, location, NACIS, year, program, or dataset
- **Map as a Selection.** Provides the option for users to select a location from a map by a point, polygon, rectangle, or circle, when searching for Census data
- **Faceted Filtering.** Allows users to refine their search results by selecting additional search criteria
- **Table View.** Displays data in table format and provides users with the ability to transpose datasets and download in CSV format
- **Multi-select Geographies.** Allows users to choose from multiple geographies levels when searching for data



# CEDSCI Vision

- Enable data to be easily *discovered*, *accessed*, and *consumed*
- Make data useful for a *diverse set of customer needs* (internal and external)
- Take advantage of *digital opportunities*
- **Consolidate** data dissemination systems, processes, and tools while using existing tools better to drive *efficient and effective enterprise-wide dissemination operations*
- **Centralize and standardize** the data, metadata, and software needed to build dissemination tools
