


# CENSUS 2000: MONTANA

Source: U.S. Census Bureau, Census 2000, Census Block Population. There are two figures because of the way the Census Bureau collects data - the number of people that live in each Census Block in the state is known, but if a Census Block is partly inside and partly outside of the 25- (50- or 100-) mile circle, there is no way to know how many of the people in that Block are inside the circle. The "Minimum" figure is the people in Blocks completely inside the circle, the "Maximum" figure adds in the people in Blocks that touch the circle. These figures do not include areas in Wyoming.
